- Referees you have nominated
- Organisations or tradespeople required to carry out maintenance to the premises
- · Rental Bond Authorities
- Residential Tenancy Tribunals / Courts and Statutory Authorities (where necessary)
- Collection Agents/Lawyers (where default/enforcement action is required)
- Banks, Utilities (Gas, Electricity, Water, Phone)
- Employers, etc. to provide confirmation details on your behalf
- · In the case of commercial leases, to credit bureaus for risk assessment purposes
- Other Real Estate Agents and Landlords
- In addition, there may be circumstances where we are required or authorised by law to disclose your personal information e.g. to an Ombudsman, tribunal, court, law enforcement agency or government department.

If your personal information is not provided to us and NTD and you do not consent to the uses to which we put your personal information, we cannot properly determine the risk to our client, or carry out our duties as property managers. Consequently, we may not provide you with the lease/tenancy of the premises.
